

2022 Summer Camp Information

Camp Dates:

Youth Camp 1

Monday, June 13 – Saturday, June 18 cost: \$265
(students completing grades 2-12)*
*registration deadline: June 8***

Youth Camp 2

Monday, June 27 – Saturday, July 2 cost: \$265
(students completing grades 7-12)*
*registration deadline: June 21***

Kids' Camp 1

Tuesday, July 5 – Saturday, July 9 cost \$215
(students completing grades 3-6)*
*registration deadline: July 3***

Kids' Camp 2

Monday, July 11 – Friday, July 15 cost: \$215
(students completing grades 3-6)*
*registration deadline: July 8***

Junior High Camp

Monday, July 18 – Friday, July 22 cost: \$215
(students completing grades 6-8)*
*registration deadline: July 15***

**Note that students currently finishing 6th and 8th grades have the option of several camps. They should choose only one camp to attend. We do recommend that 6th graders who attend a middle school go to the Junior High Camp.*

***Please note that camps may fill up before their registration deadlines. Please sign up soon in order to secure your spots!*

Save \$10 per camper when you sign up as a group!

Beginning of Camp: Check in for all camps runs from 3:00-5:00pm on the first scheduled day. Please note that our small staff cannot accommodate early arrivals.

End of Camp: All camps will end at 11:00am on the last day listed.

Transportation: Cowboy's Rest does not provide transportation to or from camp. For safety and liability reasons, we kindly ask that high school students do not drive their own vehicles to camp.

How you can help:

Please work to arrange rides for campers from your church to and from camp (in vehicles suited for dirt roads).

Registration: *there are two ways to register your campers...*

- 1) **Registration As Individuals:** campers send their registration forms directly to Cowboy's Rest. Upon receiving the form and deposit, we will register that camper and mail him or her an informational letter and medical release form. Our registrar will collect the balance of camp tuition as well as medical releases when the campers arrive at camp.
 - a. **by mail:**

How you can help:

Please ensure that all of your students have mailed in their Registration Forms and deposits before the deadlines. (The earlier the better!)

- 2) **Registration As A Group.** If your church would prefer to reserve a block of spaces for your campers and handle camper sign-ups and monies yourselves, use this option.

Group Registration Rates: \$215 per camper (5-day camp), \$265 per camper (6-day camp)

Group Registration Requirements: churches registering as groups are required to provide...

- **counselors** for all campers (1 counselor for every 7 campers of the same gender)
- paperwork for all campers and counselors (provided in group registration packet)
- transportation to and from camp for all campers
- payment for all campers in the form of a single check from your organization

How you can help:

- *distributing flyers to the students*
- *encouraging and reminding students to register*
- *answering questions and assisting with registration and scholarship forms*
- *keeping track of the number of campers planning to attend from your church.*
- *arranging transportation for campers from your church*
- *ensuring that all campers have their signed Medical Release Forms before embarking for camp*

COUNSELORS : If your church is registering as a group, all counselors must....

- submit a Group Counselor Application (available online or on the enclosed DVD) at least a week before attending camp
- read our Counselor Handbook (available online or on the enclosed DVD), sign the Agreement form, and bring it to camp
- complete a staff medical form and bring it to camp

Scholarships : Each summer, Cowboy's Rest offers a limited number of partial scholarships covering up to 50% of tuition for campers needing financial assistance.

- Scholarship application forms can be downloaded from our website
- The application should be filled out by a pastor, Sunday school teacher, or other Christian individual with knowledge of the camper.
- *Applications are due no later than two weeks prior to the start of camp.*
- All decisions to award scholarships are made by members of the Cowboy's Rest Board of Directors.
- We also encourage your church to establish its own scholarship and fundraising programs.

What Campers Should Bring:

warm sleeping bag ● pillow ● warm pajamas
warm clothes (long sleeve shirts, long pants)
cool clothes (modest T-shirts and shorts)
jacket ● toiletries ● extra undergarments & socks
modest, one piece swimsuit ● towels
sturdy, closed-toed shoes ● hat (to keep the sun off)
water bottle ● sunblock ● chapstick ● bug spray
small backpack ● flashlight ● pen or pencil ● Bible

How you can help:

Collect and label medications from campers before they embark for camp to give to the camp nurse. (Labels available on the enclosed DVD.)

A note about medications: *Any medications that your campers need to take during camp must be turned in during registration. They will be administered by our camp nurse.*

Optional Stuff to Bring:

fishing pole and tackle ● hiking boots ● water shoes
extra \$\$ for camp store & activities ● Super Spirit day get-up

Stuff NOT to Bring:

dangerous or illegal substances (drugs, alcohol, firearms, fireworks, etc.)
electronics (iPods, cell phones, video games, etc.) ● pets ● expensive items ● extra food
